The Lead Teacher is responsible for providing engaging activities and emotional support for children ages 2-6 years-old. The Lead Teacher will work alongside parent volunteers, providing direction to parents and support teachers who work as part of the teaching team. The Lead Teacher will also be responsible for maintaining the classroom environment and interest centers, organizing and supervising field trips, writing daily observations of all children, and sharing digital photo collections weekly.
